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Building a Reading Life!

Fiction Unit

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Unit Description

This unit will focus on building lifelong habits of becoming stronger readers! Students will build their reading life by choosing books wisely (what they are interested in and books at their independent level). Students will also begin to build their reading stamina, keep track of how their reading is going by using a reading log and learn to ask and answer questions by referring back to the text. In addition, our readers will learn how to apply comprehension strategies for predicting and summarizing. Students will also learn to think deeply about characters by making inferences using the actions and behaviors of the character to identify the character's traits.

In writing, students will focus on a narrative to write in sequential order and will include details that bring the story to life. The ultimate goal is for students to develop increased independence and dramatic growth in the level of their writing
